We were blessed to be able to stay with a sweet, young couple from First Baptist Church in Corona, NY who attend the Spanish service. Robinson and Denise Colorado gave up their room for the week to make my wife and I feel at home away from home. I am so thankful that God uses other people to impact our ministry in such a way.

The repairs had just recently been finished when Sandy once again flooded his home. I was able to return to New York, along with a fellow church member from my home church, and was joined by several volunteers from Fellowship Baptist Church of Baden, PA and from Grace Baptist in Monroeville, PA to rebuild, re-hang drywall and take care of some miscellaneous projects for Pastor. While there, Pastor Sager became ill one Sunday and I was afforded the privilege of preaching the four Sunday services at his church. The spirit was sweet, and we saw 2 souls saved!

Physical construction projects included a total remodel of a parsonage, hardwood flooring, plumbing repairs and bathroom remodel, replacing windows, re-siding, masonry and concrete work, various building repairs and maintenance, drywall, and several miscellaneous smaller projects.
